Travel to Cambridge

By Train

Robinson College is situated in the centre of Cambridge, approximately 10-15 minutes by taxi from the main railway station and the bus station (terminus for the airport coaches). Frequent departures are from King's Cross and Liverpool Street stations in London. Direct services also operate from Birmingham, Liverpool, Manchester and Nottingham.
